

Instructions for the U.S. Customs Power of Attorney Form 5291

STEP 1 — Print or type your name and social security number on the first line.

STEP 2 — Sign your name on the line next to (signature).

STEP 3 — Put the date when the form was signed on the line next to the word “date”

NOTE: This form gives the DMS partner agent in the U.S. the authority to clear your personal effects and household goods through U.S. Customs without your presence. The form must be completed along with the Customs Form 3299 and Supplemental Declaration for Unaccompanied Personal and Household Effects.
